No university can license a counselor. That is in all cases a prerogative of the individual state, which might or might not have a reciprocal agreement with any other state. Every state requires additional hours of supervised counseling after graduation in addition to an ethics test and whatever exam the state uses as its licensing tool.</p> <p><b>**Before beginning CNSL 5360, students must meet the following prerequisites: successful completion of CNSL 5307, a minimum of 24 credit hours in the counseling program, purchase of malpractice insurance, and a signed site agreement.</b></p>
